



# **Mobility Rules**

Applicable from the class of 2025-2027

### 1. Erasmus Mundus mobility rules

According to the Erasmus Mundus programme, each student must study in at least two countries different from their country of residence.

#### **Important notes:**

- French and Italian students: You must study in two countries other than France or Italy, whether in the semesters 2, 3 or 4 (the semester 4 (master thesis) counts for a mobility period).
- This same rule applies to students of **other nationalities** who have resided long-term in France or Italy before joining the programme.

This is a core condition of the Erasmus Mundus programme and must be strictly followed.

## 2. Quarmen Mobility rules

#### 2.a. Semester 2

• Your mobility choice for Semester 2 is made during the **application stage**.

#### **Visa Information:**

- Non-EU students accepted at the University of Porto are strongly encouraged to apply for a Portuguese visa in their home country before the programme starts.
  - The Portuguese Consulate in Rome does **not** issue visas to students without an Italian residence permit.
  - The University of Porto will provide all necessary supporting documents for your visa application.
- Students assigned to Université Paris-Saclay will be able to apply for a French visa in Rome during the first semester.





#### 2.b. Semester 3

- The choice of mobility for Semester 3 is also made during the application stage.
- A maximum of 4/5 students will be selected to study at the University of Toronto for both Semester 3 and Semester 4.

### 2.c. Semester 4 – Internship / Master Thesis

Internships or Master's theses should maintain **administrative and geographic continuity** with Semester 3.

#### **University of Toronto:**

- Students studying at the **University of Toronto in Semester 3** are expected to **remain in Canada** for their Master's thesis.
- Only the **4/5 students selected for Semester 3 the University of Toronto** may carry out their thesis there.

#### **Université Paris-Saclay:**

- Students at **Université Paris-Saclay in Semester 3** are expected to carry out their Semester 4 master's thesis in the **European partners** of the consortium, choosing from available labs and projects in:
  - Sapienza University of Rome
  - University of Porto
  - Paris-Saclay Univ. & area

#### **Industry internships:**

- Internships with **startups and companies** in the assigned semester 4 partner countries are possible.
  - In such cases, supervision will be provided by a **faculty member** from one of the three partner universities who has expertise in the chosen topic.

Applicants must indicate their mobility preferences for Semesters 2, 3, and 4 in the application form. The selection jury will propose placements based on the availability at each university, while taking students' preferences into account.
